Situation Overview

More than a week after the 26 August floods, the response has progressively shifted from search and rescue to relief and recovery efforts. According to NDRRMA, 1,355 people have died, 4,996 remain out of contact, 13,396 have been rescued, and 6,672 injured. A total of 98 bodies has been identified and handed over to families. Deaths have been reported in eight districts, with the highest numbers in Chitwan (360), Nawalparasi East (222), Nawalparasi West (219), Nuwakot (195), and Rasuwa (156). Search operations continue in five hydropower tunnels to date. Access continues to be the main operational challenge, as damaged roads and bridges are hampering the delivery of relief supplies to upper Rasuwa, with some affected areas accessible only by foot.

A total of 39 holding centres are sheltering 3,533 people, including 2,651 in Nuwakot, 669 in Rasuwa and 213 in Dhading. The restoration of basic services is progressing, with electricity restored to 99.8% of households in Dhading, 96.7% in Nuwakot, and around 78% in Rasuwa. Solar systems are being provided to support affected households, while most mobile towers are operational, though some areas in Rasuwa remain without connectivity.

Recovery is expected to be prolonged in the worst-affected areas. The Nepali Army estimates that clearing mud, rocks and debris from the hydropower tunnels may take three to four months.

NRCS Response

Health

- 51 volunteers mobilized across four districts with 12 volunteers supporting PFA/MHPSS activities across five wards of Bidur Municipality.
- 58 people received PFA/MHPSS support in Nuwakot, reporting concerns including anxiety, sleep difficulties, emotional distress, substance use, guilt, and uncertainty over future livelihoods, one person was referred to a psychiatric doctor for further support.
- NRCS Red Cross Emergency Clinic (RCEC) team deployed in Nuwakot and started clinic set up.

WASH

- Installed and operationalized two 5,000-litre water storage tanks, each with three tap stands, at Hawa Ghar and the Holding Centre in Bidur Municipality-4.
- Installed two additional 5,000-litre water tanks at the NRCS District Chapter premises and Arki Tole, Bidur-4; operationalization is ongoing.
- Set up one 5 m³ bladder tank with a tap stand, benefiting approximately 100 households.
- Coordinated with Bidhan WUC for the provision of bleaching powder. CASH profiles are deployed in affected areas for damage assessment and verifying damaged WASH infrastructures to be rehabilitated.

Shelter

- NRCS collaboratively with Plan International, World Vision, Chaudhary Group, and Karuna Foundation, mobilized volunteers conducting detailed data collection at holding centers in Nuwakot.
- Kobo assessment orientation for cash and voucher assistance in Nuwakot district chapter- Rasuwa flash flood response operation
- 12 volunteers supported six Child-Friendly Spaces (CFS), delivering health, educational, and other child-focused support at various holding centres.
- NFIs distribution and temporary shelter are being set up in different affected areas regularly.
- Working closely with concerned local government authorities and other agencies for effective service delivery.

Restoring Family Link (RFL):

- 85 new cases registered, bringing the total to 708; tracing continued through hospitals, shelters, and affected areas.
- RFL Help Desks are operational in Rasuwa, Chitwan, Nuwakot, Kaski, and Nawalparasi East, with volunteers supporting family reconnection, phone services, and DNA sample collection.
- 8 Vulnerable Separated Children (VSCs) were registered in Nuwakot.

ICRC :

- Procured 2000 body bags distributed to support the dignified management of the deceased.
- Surge Support.
- Support the RFL Activities.

Red Cross Continues Water Relief Efforts in Nuwakot After Floods

Nepal Red Cross Society has launched a drinking water service in Bidur Municipality of Nuwakot district, an area affected by the Bhotekoshi flood in Rasuwa. Working in coordination with the Bidur Drinking Water Consumers' Committee, the organization has installed 5,000-liter capacity water tanks at five critical locations across the municipality and begun distributing water.

Since Saturday, the service has been running in areas including Battar Hawaghar, the Arkit road, and the route to the bus park. Around 400 households are expected to directly benefit from the initiative.

With flooding having disrupted the regular water supply, the Red Cross is working with local authorities and water user committees to continue providing clean and safe drinking water to affected residents. The organization says similar humanitarian support is ongoing in Nuwakot and other flood-hit districts as well.
